

QUIDDITCHUK INDIVIDUAL MEMBERSHIP POLICY

TYPES OF MEMBERSHIP

Student Members

Student Members may register and compete on any QuidditchUK club without restriction. However, we strongly encourage students to compete within University based clubs as they align strongest in terms of competitive ecosystem and season calendar.

A student member is defined as a member of QuidditchUK who is currently registered, enrolled, or otherwise affiliated with a university or educational institution as a student. This definition extends from those in secondary school or college, part-time students, up to and including post-graduate or mature students.

A student does not have to be studying at the University associated with their chosen club.

Community Members

Community Members may register and compete with any QuidditchUK club. However, restrictions may apply for the number of Community Members that can be registered on a University Team at official QuidditchUK events.

These restrictions are outlined on the Club and Team Membership Policy.

A community member is defined as any other member who is not affiliated with any university or educational institution as a student.

MEMBERSHIP

Membership Benefits

Eligibility to register for and compete at QuidditchUK official events and QuidditchUK affiliated events.

Eligibility to qualify for and compete in the European Quidditch Cup.

Included under QuidditchUK Public Liability insurance whenever training or competing with official QuidditchUK clubs or events.

Access to coaching, refereeing, and snitching resources and training provided by QuidditchUK.

Access to QuidditchUK grants and funding provided via your club.

Eligibility to be scouted and selected for QuidditchUK-recognised national training squads.

Eligibility to be selected to compete at International Quidditch Association competitions.

Coverage and regulation of transfers within European clubs overseen by Quidditch Europe.

Access to discounts and perks from QuidditchUK through our affiliated partners.

Register under a single QuidditchUK Club.

Transfer between QuidditchUK Clubs.

Members Must

Register with QuidditchUK as a member to compete in any official or affiliated QuidditchUK event.

Register with an active QuidditchUK club (*registration with a club does not guarantee selection for any tournament your club's team(s) may compete at*).

Be at least 18 Years Old (*members aged 16 or 17 are permitted with written consent from their legal guardian. A person turning 16 midway through the season, may become a member and compete in tournaments immediately following their 16th birthday. Members under aged 16-17 must also have written clearance by their QuidditchUK club*).

Not have any bans or suspensions placed on them by QuidditchUK, or any other governing body recognised by the European Quidditch Federation or the International Quidditch Association.

Adhere to all Tournament Policies.

Respect their fellow teammates, opponents, match officials, and all other QuidditchUK staff both on and off pitch, publicly and privately.

Members Must Not

Publicly or privately demonstrate hate towards any individual, group, race, gender, disability, sexuality, religion or ethnicity.

Refuse either publicly or privately to observe any individual's preferred gender identity after multiple corrections.

Refuse either publicly or privately to compete with or against an individual on the grounds of their race, gender, sexuality, religion or ethnicity.

Exhibit any other kind of behaviour or action which is deemed racist, sexist, ableist, gender-based, homophobic, transphobic, motivated by religious hatred, or anything deemed to be equivalent.
