

Scorekeeper Code of Conduct

All scorekeepers must be at the pitch at least 5 minutes before the brooms up time for the match (where possible) in case the Head Referee wishes to brief them.

Scorekeepers **MUST:**

- Keep score for the game accurately, ensuring they understand the head referee calls and signals
- Ensure the displayed score to the pitch is accurate at all times and easily viewable
- Where possible, note the card given, the foul committed and the player name/number for any cards given by the head referee
- Use the new European snitch catch notation (see attachment on SMOF)
- Ensure the head referee agrees with the score given at the end of the match, before signing the sheet
- Ensure both captains and all referees sign the score sheet
- Yield their opinion on the score to the head referee if the head referee has a different score

Scorekeepers **MUST NOT:**

- Dedicate any attention to distractions during the match to ensure the score is accurate and up to date
- Purposefully give an incorrect score to a team during the match
- Leave without good reason during the game
